OUTPATIENT SURGERY PREOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

The Week before Surgery:

- Expect a call from your nurse within a week of your scheduled surgery to review your pre-operative instructions and medical history.
- If you take daily medication, check with Northwest Surgery Center about what to do the morning of your surgery regarding your medication.

The Night before Surgery:

• Use an antiseptic skin cleanser such as "Hibiclens". Follow directions given below.

The Morning of Your Surgery:

- Bathe or shower, to reduce the chance of infection.
- Be at the facility at the time given you. Your surgery could be canceled if you do not arrive in adequate time.
- Wear loose fitting clothing.
- Leave your valuables at home.
- If you have a cold, a fever of 100 degrees F or higher, a skin rash or an infection of any kind, notify Northwest Surgery Center before coming in for your surgery.

After Your Surgery:

- After you leave the operating room, you will be taken to the recovery room for a brief period. From there you will be released to go home by the physician.
- For you own safety, a responsible adult MUST drive you home if you have taken a valium.

Within 24 after Your Surgery:

You will receive a follow up call from your nurse.

Special Tips:

- If you have any problems, please call the facility. If after hours press 2 to reach a staff member.
- You will receive a telephone call after surgery from one of our nurses, to inquire as to how you are feeling. If you have any concerns, please discuss them with the nurse.
- Please limit to two (2) the number of people accompanying you. These people are welcome to stay or we will call them when you are ready to go home.
- Times vary, but you can plan that you will be with us from one to three (1-3) hours.
- If there is a possibility that you are pregnant, please be sure to discuss this with your physician.
- You will be given a prescription for medication after your surgery understand that admission to the hospital may be a
 possibility if my physician so decides.

Foot Scrub Directions

Wash your foot 3-5 minutes making sure to wash all areas of the foot, ankle and in between toes. Do not allow soap/shampoo to come in contact with the foot after the scrub because it will deactivate the antiseptic. Dry foot completely with a clean towel, then apply a clean sock. Do not apply body lotion or powder to your foot after washing it.

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
